Chirakan Charoenvicha is an attending staff in the Division of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, Faculty of Medicine, Chiang Mai University, Thailand. She also serves as a craniofacial surgeon at the Princess Sirindhorn IT Foundation Craniofacial Center and as a consultant at Sriphat Medical Center and Bangkok Hospital Chiang Mai.
